TAKING THE WORST OF THE WORST OFF THE STREETS

Capital Area Regional Fugitive Task Force (CARFTF)

On June 11, 2007, Neville Holly was arrested in the Bronx, NY by members of CARFTF, the Technical Operations Group (TOG), and the New York / New Jersey Regional Fugitive Task Force (NY/NJ RFTF). The Washington, DC Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) wanted Holly for Murder While Armed after he allegedly killed a person on May 12, 2007. CARFTF investigators and MPD detectives developed information indicating that Holly fled to New York. CARFTF personnel traveled to New York, and with the assistance of TOG and NY/NJ RFTF, identified Holly's location at a home in the Bronx. Investigators responded to the target home, observed Holly, and safely took him into custody. Holly remains in custody pending removal to Washington, DC.

New York/New Jersey Regional Fugitive Task Force (NY/NJ RFTF)

On June 12, 2007, Duane Morrison was arrested in Schenectady, NY by members of NY/NJ RFTF. The Albany, NY Police Department (APD) sought Morrison following his escape from custody during questioning. APD originally took Morrison into custody for questioning in relation to a shooting that occurred on June 10, 2006. During that incident Morrison allegedly shot two victims after they became involved in an altercation with his brother. When APD questioned Morrison regarding the shooting, he stated that authorities in New York, NY wanted him for violating parole. Morrison later escaped from custody when detectives left the interview room. APD contacted NY/NJ RFTF investigators for assistance in locating and apprehending Morrison. NY/NJ RFTF investigators identified Morrison's probable location in Schenectady, responded to that site, and safely took him into custody following a brief foot pursuit. Authorities later charged Morrison with multiple counts of Attempted Murder, as well as Escape.

Pacific Southwest Regional Fugitive Task Force (PSWRFTF)

On June 16, 2007, Dao Lan Ong was arrested in Alhambra, CA by members of PSWRFTF, inspectors from the Technical Operations Group (TOG), deputy US marshals (DUSMs) from the Central District of California, and officers from the Alhambra Police Department (APD). APD wanted Ong for Kidnapping, Robbery, Carjacking, Burglary, and weapons violations. These charges relate to a series of incidents from May to June 2007 during which Ong allegedly assaulted drivers at gunpoint and demanded that those victims take him to an ATM and withdraw funds. Ong would also allegedly steal other valuables belonging to the victims, including their vehicles, and would later attempt to extort additional funds from the victims in exchange for the return of those vehicles. On June 12, 2007, APD contacted PSWRFTF for assistance in locating and apprehending Ong. PSWRFTF, with critical assistance from TOG, developed information on Ong's location in Alhambra, responded to that site, and observed a male matching Ong's description sitting in a parked vehicle. Investigators surrounded the vehicle, ordered Ong to exit, and safely took him into custody. A search conducted incident to arrest resulted in the seizure of a handgun from the driver's seat where Ong had been sitting.

Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force (GLRFTF)

Vice Lords Gang Member

On June 12, 2007, Shantrell Tucker, a documented member of the *Vice Lords* gang, was arrested in Chicago, IL by members of GLRFTF. The Chicago Police Department (CPD) wanted Tucker for Homicide after an incident on May 25, 2007. On that date, Tucker, along with two associates, allegedly shot into a rival gang member's vehicle, killing one and wounding two. Authorities immediately took Tucker's alleged accomplices into custody, but Tucker remained at large. On May 28, 2007, CPD requested GLRFTF assistance in locating and apprehending Tucker. GLRFTF developed information on Tucker's location at a residence in Chicago, responded to that site, and safely took him into custody.

Gulf Coast Regional Fugitive Task Force (GCRFTF)

On June 11, 2007, Leo Miller was arrested in Gulf Shores, AL by members of GCRFTF, who acted with critical assistance from the Technical Operations Group (TOG). Authorities in Montgomery, AL wanted Miller for Sexual Abuse after he allegedly sexually abused a nine year old boy. GCRFTF developed information indicating that Miller fled to Gulf Shores, where he worked on a construction site. Investigators responded to that location, observed Miller attempting to leave the area in a vehicle, and safely took him into custody.

Southeast Regional Fugitive Task Force (SERFTF)

On June 06, 2007, Jamal Lawson was arrested in Atlanta, GA by members of SERFTF. The Richland County (SC) Sheriff's Department (RCSD) wanted Lawson for Criminal Sexual Conduct with a Minor, as well as for Aggravated Assault and Battery. These charges relate to a series of incidents in 2006, during which Lawson allegedly attempted to molest two minors as they slept. The victims later identified Lawson as their attacker. RCSD investigators developed information indicating that Lawson fled to an Atlanta-area apartment with a female associate, and with the support of deputy US marshals (DUSMs) in the District of South Carolina, contacted SERFTF for assistance in locating and apprehending Lawson. SERFTF established surveillance at the target apartment and identified Lawson as he exited the residence. Investigators later approached the apartment, announced their presence, and safely took Lawson into custody as he attempted to flee from the rear of the residence. Lawson remains in custody pending extradition to South Carolina. Lawson, who was previously convicted for Resisting Arrest, also faces a Cobb County (GA) charge for domestic violence.
