TAKING THE WORST OF THE WORST OFF THE STREETS

Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force (GLRFTF)

On July 05, 2007, Darrin Larnell Adams was arrested in Chicago, IL by members of GLRFTF. The Chesterfield County (VA) Police Department wanted Adams for Rape and Strong Arm Rape of a Child after he allegedly sexually assaulted an eleven year old girl. Adams allegedly forced the victim to engage in sexual acts with him for more than a year until she disclosed the assaults to a family member. DNA analysis linked Adam to the assaults on the victim. Adams fled Virginia shortly after learning of the charges against him. GLRFTF identified several of Adams' family members, and during the early morning hours of July 05, identified his location. Investigators responded to the target site and safely took Adams into custody as he hid in a boiler room.

New York/New Jersey Regional Fugitive Task Force (NY/NJ RFTF)

On July 07, 2007, Tyre S. Milledge, a documented member of the *Bloods* gang, was arrested in Dublin, GA by members of the Southeast Regional Fugitive Task Force (SERFTF), who acted on information developed by NY/NJ RFTF. Authorities in New Jersey wanted Milledge for Homicide, Aggravated Assault with a Weapon, and weapons violations. These charges relate to an incident during which Milledge allegedly shot and killed a forty-nine year old woman as she sat on her porch with her son. Authorities allege that Milledge shot the victim in retaliation for a previous act by her son. NY/NJ RFTF identified information indicating that Milledge fled to Georgia, and contacted SERFTF for assistance. SERFTF identified Milledge's location in Dublin, responded to that site, and safely took him into custody.

Gulf Coast Regional Fugitive Task Force (GCRFTF)

On July 07, 2007, Thomas Guyton was arrested in Jackson, MS by members of GCRFTF. Authorities wanted Guyton for Failure to Register as a Sex Offender. Guyton's requirement to register a sex offender related to a 1987 conviction in Mississippi for the rape and sexual assault of an eighteen year old woman. GCRFTF identified Guyton's location at a family member's home, responded to that site, and established surveillance. Investigators later observed Guyton exit the home, moved in, and safely took him into custody. Guyton has a lengthy criminal history of arrests for sex offenses and Armed Robbery.

Southeast Regional Fugitive Task Force (SERFTF)

On July 05, 2007, Jeffery Woodward was arrested in Gray, GA by members of SERFTF and deputies from the Jones County (GA) Sheriff's Office (JCSO). The Macon, GA Police Department and JCSO wanted Woodward for Aggravated Child Molestation. These charges relate to Woodward's alleged abduction and molestation of a fifteen year old girl on July 04, 2007. On July 05, two additional children stated that Woodward had been molesting them over a period of several years. Within two hours of receiving a request for assistance from JCSO, SERFTF located Woodward in Gray. Investigators established surveillance, and later observed Woodward flee from the rear of the target residence. SERFTF units discovered Woodward hiding in a ditch a short distance away. Investigators also took Woodward's mother and stepfather into custody on charges of Obstruction after they lied regarding Woodward's presence inside their home.

Capital Area Regional Fugitive Task Force (CARFTF)

On July 03, 2007, Azariah Isreal was arrested in Washington, DC by members of CARFTF. The Washington, DC Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) wanted Isreal for multiple charges, including Murder While Armed, Assault with Intent to Kill, and Aggravated Assault While Armed. These charges relate date to June 22, 2007. CARFTF identified Isreal's location in Southeast Washington, DC, responded to that site, and safely took him into custody.

Pacific Southwest Regional Fugitive Task Force (PSWRFTF)

On July 06, 2007, Bobby Perez was arrested in Mira Loma, CA by members of PSWRFTF, officers from the El Monte, CA Police Department, and investigators from the Los Angeles County (CA) District Attorney's Office. Authorities wanted Perez for Assault with a Deadly Weapon, Hate Crimes, and Participating in Gang Violence. These charges relate to an incident on June 16, 2007, during which Perez and a group of his associates allegedly approached a group of men who lived in a group home. Perez and his associates allegedly began shouting racial slurs towards the men before physically attacking them. The victims suffered multiple injuries, to include two of the men who received stab wounds. Authorities later identified Perez as one of the alleged assailants and requested assistance from PSWRFTF in locating and apprehending him. Investigators later located Perez in a warehouse and safely took him into custody.
