TAKING THE WORST OF THE WORST OFF THE STREETS

#### Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force (GLRFTF)

On August 07, 2007, Daniel Isunza, a documented member of the **Spanish Gangster Disciples** gang, was arrested in Elgin, IL by members of GLRFTF. The Illinois Department of Corrections wanted Isunza for Parole Violation, while authorities also sought him for questioning in relation to the shooting of five people, two of whom died. GLRFTF investigators developed information on Isunza's location, responded to that site, and safely took him into custody. Incident to Isunza's arrest, investigators seized the following items: a loaded .357 magnum handgun, a .25 caliber semi-automatic handgun, a sawed-off shotgun, quantities of cocaine and marijuana, more than 500 rounds of ammunition, an amount of US currency, a narcotics scale, packaging materials, and gang photographs. Isunza, a prior convicted felon, will face additional narcotics and weapons related charges.

#### Gulf Coast Regional Fugitive Task Force (GCRFTF)

On August 07, 2007, Jon Wayne Johnson was arrested in Guntersville, AL by members of GCRFTF. Authorities in Wagoner County (OK) wanted Johnson for Failure to Register as a Sex Offender and Violation of Probation. These charges relate to a prior conviction for Lewd & Indecent Acts with a Child. GCRFTF targeted Johnson after receiving a request for assistance from local officials in Alabama, who became suspicious of Johnson after he moved to the Guntersville area. Investigators developed information indicating that Johnson began the process of altering his appearance and obtaining fraudulent identification documents. After confirming Johnson's wanted status, investigators identified his location, established surveillance at that site, and later took him into custody without incident. Johnson, who initially denied his identity, faces additional charges of Failure to Register as a Sex Offender in Marshall County (AL).

#### New York/New Jersey Regional Fugitive Task Force (NY/NJ RFTF)

On August 06, 2007, Isiah Waters was arrested in Schenectady, NY by members of NY/NJ RFTF. The Schenectady Police Department wanted Waters for Murder after he allegedly shot and killed a male victim on June 22, 2007. During that incident, Waters allegedly chased the victim into a residence and shot him nine times in the back, killing him. NY/NJ RFTF investigators developed information indicating that Waters fled to Baltimore, MD, via Westchester County (NY). Investigators later learned that Waters returned to Schenectady to live in a female associate's apartment. NY/NJ RFTF teams responded to the target location, observed Waters, and safely took him into custody. Incident to Waters' arrest, investigators seized a loaded handgun and took his female associate into custody on Harboring and other charges.

### **Southeast Regional Fugitive Task Force (SERFTF)**

On August 08, 2007, Roger Ballard was arrested in Atlanta, GA by members of SERFTF. Authorities wanted Ballard for multiple charges, including Rape and Aggravated Sodomy, which related to the sexual assault of a sixteen year old girl. These charges pertain to a series of incidents during which Ballard allegedly forcibly engaged in sexual acts with the victim. During one occurrence when another person nearly happened upon an ongoing assault, Ballard allegedly choked the victim and threatened to kill her if she made any noise. Authorities became aware of the assaults after the victim came forward to them. On July 25, 2007, the Atlanta Police Department obtained warrants for Ballard's arrest, and later contacted SERFTF for assistance in locating and apprehending him. Investigators identified Ballard's location at a residence in Atlanta, established surveillance there, and later took him into custody. Ballard has a lengthy prior criminal record, including at least sixteen arrests for Enticing a Child, Impersonating an Officer, and Burglary.

### **Capital Area Regional Fugitive Task Force (CARFTF)**

On August 10, 2007, Shari Pryor and Carlitta Williams were arrested in Baltimore, MD by members of CARFTF. The Richmond Police Department wanted Pryor and Williams for Felony Child Neglect, a charge relating to their role in the death of Pryor's four year old daughter. Pryor and Williams both raised the victim. When authorities investigated the child's death, Pryor and Williams stated that the fatal injuries resulted from a fall. A post-mortem exam performed on the victim's body revealed evidence of persistent physical abuse, which likely lasted for more than two years. The exam concluded in the determination that the victim died as a result of a severe beating. CARFTF investigators developed information indicating that Pryor and Williams fled from Richmond, and that they would likely travel to Connecticut. Investigators later located Pryor and Williams at a residence in Baltimore, responded to that site, and safely took both subjects into custody. Since Williams' arrest, the charges against her have been upgraded to include Murder.

### **Pacific Southwest Regional Fugitive Task Force (PSWRFTF)**

On August 06, 2007, Roland Ramos was arrested in Gardena, CA by members of PSWRFTF and investigators from the Riverside County (CA) Sheriff's Department (RCSD). Authorities wanted Ramos for Armed Robbery, Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and False Imprisonment after an incident on August 02, 2007. On that date, Ramos, who worked as a surveillance technician at a Casino in Riverside, allegedly restrained two security guards and stole two million dollars from the casino's vault. Shortly after the robbery, RCSD identified Ramos as the alleged perpetrator and contacted PSWRFTF for assistance in locating and apprehending him. PSWRFTF investigators identified information indicating that Ramos obtained a passport in July 2007, and that he might attempt to flee the U.S. Investigators later identified Ramos' location at a motel in Gardena, responded to that site, and safely took him into custody. Incident to Ramos' arrest, investigators seized a majority of the stolen money, which had been hidden in a motel pillow case.
