

# ***Wanted by the Law?***

**Wanted for a non-violent misdemeanor crime in  
Leon, Gadsden, or Wakulla County?  
Are you an American citizen or legal resident?**

***Your first step toward a second chance.***

Surrender in safety at Bethel AME Church from Wednesday, December 8, through Saturday, December 11, 2010. Consult with an Assistant Public Defender, and speak to a Judge — all on-site. You may receive favorable consideration for your surrender, and those with non-violent misdemeanor offenses are likely to go home the same day.

This program is not for those who have warrants for child support, are juvenile offenders, have immigration issues, or warrants from any jurisdiction outside of Leon, Gadsden, or Wakulla County. Please do not bring children to the church.

Parking is limited in the area near the church; however, you can get there via Star Metro route #14. The Gadsden County Sheriff's Office and Wakulla County Sheriff's Office will be coordinating free shuttle service. Please contact the information line at 850-942-9670 for more information.

Once you clear your warrant, the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles will be on-site to assist with drivers license and photo identification issues and needs during the event.

If you are wanted for a more serious offense, you may also surrender at Bethel AME.
