- ▶ 94 U.S. marshals, one for each federal court district
- ▶ 3,571 deputy U.S. marshals and criminal investigators
- ▶ 1,451 administrative employees and detention enforcement officers
- ▶ 5,116 total employees
- ▶ 94 districts, 218 sub-offices, three foreign field offices

- ▶ FY 2018: \$1.31 billion (salaries and expenses)
