Frias is wanted by the Kay County Sheriff's Office for the murder of his estranged wife, Janett Reyna, a former police officer with the Blackwell Police Department and Domestic Violence Prevention Program Coordinator for the Ponca Tribal Police. In August 2013, Frias allegedly murdered Reyna by stabbing her 41 times in front of Reyna's three young children.
