Albuquerque Police Arrest United States Marshals Service District of New Mexico's Most Wanted.

Albuquerque, NM- On December 25, 2010 Albuquerque police arrested Gilbert Lovato during a traffic stop in Albuquerque for Driving While Intoxicated. Albuquerque Police also charged Lovato with child abuse because at the time of arrest there was a minor in the vehicle.

Lovato was one of the United States Marshals Service, District of New Mexico's most wanted Gang Fugitives. Lovato was added to the most wanted program because of his extensive criminal history in Armed Robbery and Burglary. Lovato has been arrested fifteen times and has faced numerous charges with the state of New Mexico. Lovato was on probation at the time of arrest and had an outstanding warrant for a Probation Violation in the state of New Mexico. Lovato is currently in custody awaiting trial for his numerous charges and probation violations.
