## Declaration

Whereas, the Act titled, "An Act to Establish the Judicial Court of the United States," was approved September 24, 1789, directing the appointment of United States Marshals and launching the United States Marshals Service;

Whereas, U.S. Marshals execute warrants; distribute presidential proclamations; register enemy aliens in time of war; help conduct the national census; protect the President and the federal courts; provide for the custody and transportation of federal prisoners; maintain and dispose of seized and forfeited properties; ensure the safe conduct of judicial proceedings; protect federal judges and jurors and other members of the federal judiciary; provide for the security of witnesses; and direct and coordinate fugitive task forces to apprehend dangerous fugitives;

Whereas, throughout their 225 years of history, the men and women of the United States Marshals Service have served the nation and this state valiantly, with dedication to justice, integrity, and public safety; and

Whereas, we express deep appreciation for their service and sacrifices as indispensable instruments of civil authority and law enforcement in Utah and throughout the nation;

Now, therefore, I, Gary R. Herbert, Governor of the State of Utah, do hereby declare September 24, 2014, as
