US MARSHALS PATROL THE STREETS ON HALLOWEEN

ALBUQUERQUE – This Halloween, the U.S. Marshals Service, District of New Mexico, teamed up with The U.S. Probation Office and the Bernalillo County Sheriff’s Office to conduct registered sex offender address verifications, house checks, and random patrol contacts.

Law enforcement officers knocked on doors to make sure registered sex offenders are in compliance with their probation. Halloween night has special requirements and restrictions sex offenders have to comply with.

“The Marshals Service for the District of New Mexico embraces and successfully achieves the mission of investigating and apprehending those sex offenders who violate their registration requirement and will charge those in noncompliance with violation of the Adam Walsh Act of 2006,” said District of New Mexico U.S. Marshal Conrad E. Candelaria. “Compliance is achieved with a cooperative and collaborative approach between local, county and state law enforcement agencies working together to ensure sex offenders remain compliant with their registration requirements and tonight’s operation is an example of law enforcement working together so that every child in New Mexico can live and play in a safer New Mexico”.
