New Mexico's Most Wanted Adds Three New Offenders

Albuquerque, NM-The United States Marshals Service and Task Force Officers from the United States Marshals Service Southwest Investigative Fugitive Team (SWIFT) Task Force added Paul Anthony Collins, Dakota Strausser and Robert Jones to the New Mexico's Most Wanted. Collins is wanted for allegedly violating his terms of probation for charges that include aggravated fleeing a Law Enforcement officer and evading arrest. Strausser is wanted by New Mexico Probation and Parole for allegedly violating his terms of probation. Jones is wanted on charges of Criminal Sexual Penetration of a minor (under 13) in the first degree.

Deputies and Task Force Officers assigned to the United States Marshals Service South West Investigative Fugitive Team (SWIFT) Task Force are actively trying to locate these fugitives and it is believed that they are all three still in NM.

These Fugitives are considered armed and extremely dangerous and should be reported to authorities immediately
