

Wanted by the Law?

Wanted for a non-violent crime in Delaware?
Have no history of violence?
Ready to accept responsibility for what you have done?

If you are an American citizen or legal resident and answer YES to all three of these questions, then you are eligible.

Your first step toward a second chance.

Surrender in safety at the church from Wednesday, April 29 through Saturday, May 2, 2009, consult with an attorney and speak to a judge - *at the church*. You will receive favorable consideration for your surrender, and you are likely to go home the same day.

If you are wanted for a more serious felony crime, or if you have a history of violence, you may also surrender in safety at the New Destiny Fellowship Church. There are no religious requirements.
